
CHAPERONED COMPETITIONS

SPECTATORS TRAVELLING INDEPENDENTLY TO COMPETITIONS

As a parent travelling independently (i.e., not with the club) to spectate at a competition, where your diver is on a chaperoned trip, please be aware that the chaperones of the trip are responsible for your diver throughout the duration of the trip including the competition, travel, accommodation, medication, and mealtimes. The only exception is when they are on poolside for training or during their competition where the coaches will look after the divers' welfare.

If staying overnight in the same location as the competition, you should stay at a different hotel than those travelling with the chaperoned team.

During the time you are spectating at the pool, you should encourage your diver to sit with their team at the pool / spectator area to support them during the competition, and under no circumstances take your child anywhere without notification to the lead chaperone in charge of the trip.

You are not permitted to attend team meals or enter your own diver / any other divers' rooms due to the safeguarding of all divers on the trip.
